My child is a beginning reader. What is the best way to support my child's reading over the summer: reading to my child, reading with my child or having my child read independently?

As your child learns to read, it is important to find a balance of "to, with and by" reading. Your involvement in all aspects of the reading process will lead to a pleasurable and rewarding experience for both you and your child.

Throughout the summer, allow your child pick a variety of books that are of interest to them. It is important, however, that children do not read books that are too difficult. Research has shown that reading books that are at a "frustration level" can actually stunt a reader's growth or send them backwards in their development.
