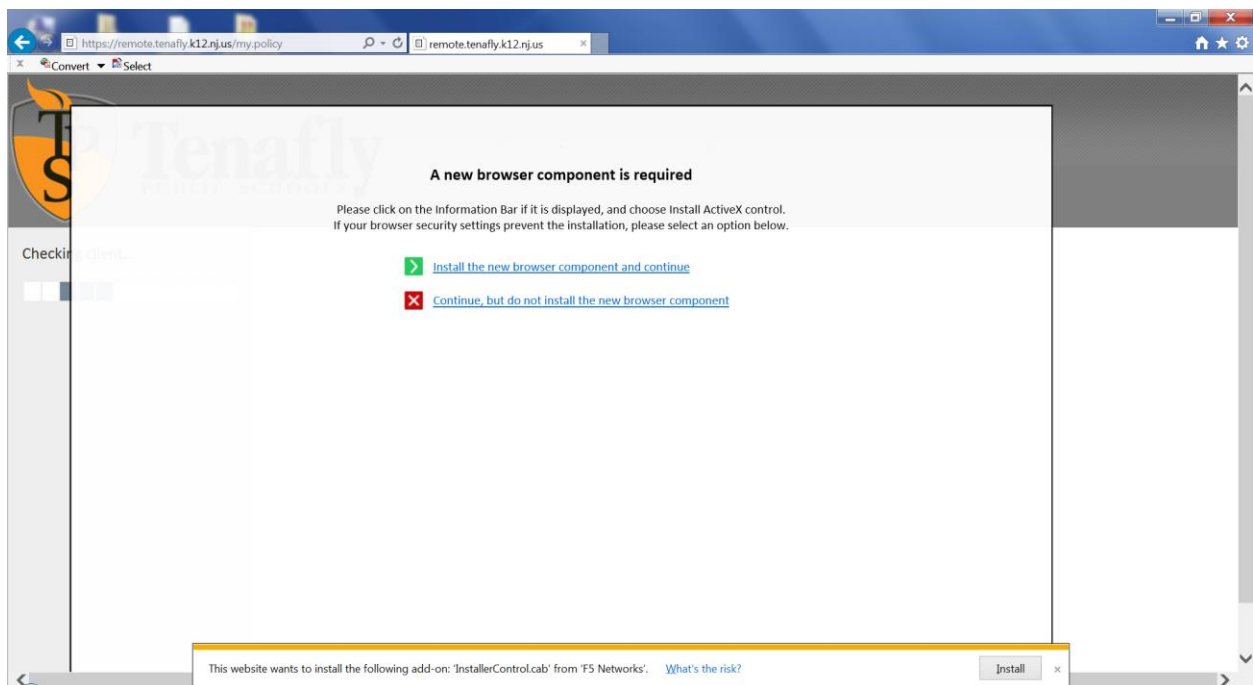


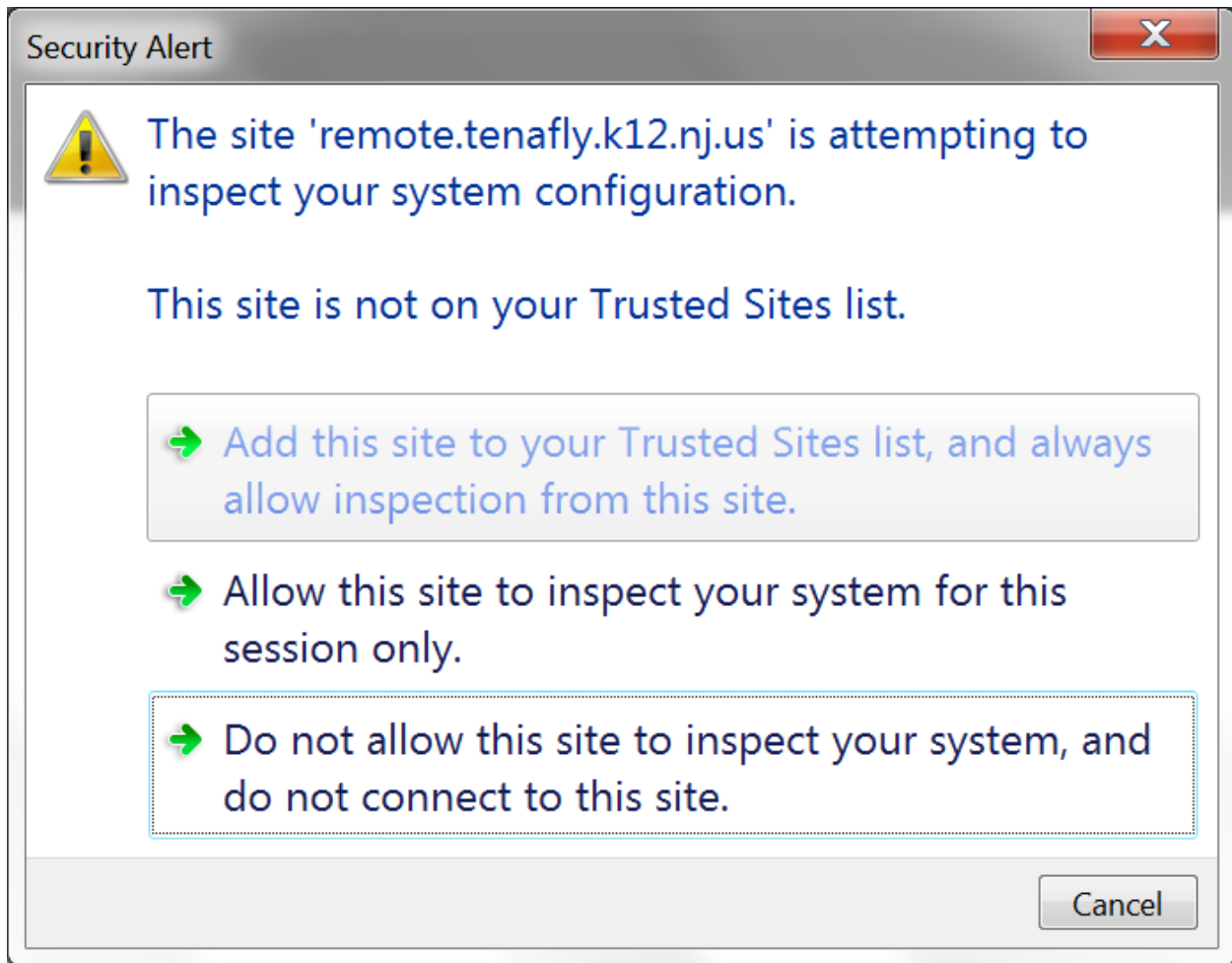
F5 Remote File Access

Tenafly Public Schools has put in place a new product to gain access to your documents in place of using the older Firepass. The new URL will be <https://remote.tenafly.k12.nj.us>. If you are using a Windows system, you will need to use IE or Firefox. As of right now Chrome doesn't fully support it. You must have an Antivirus program installed on your system to gain access. If an AV program is not found it will deny you access. Mac computers can use any browser.

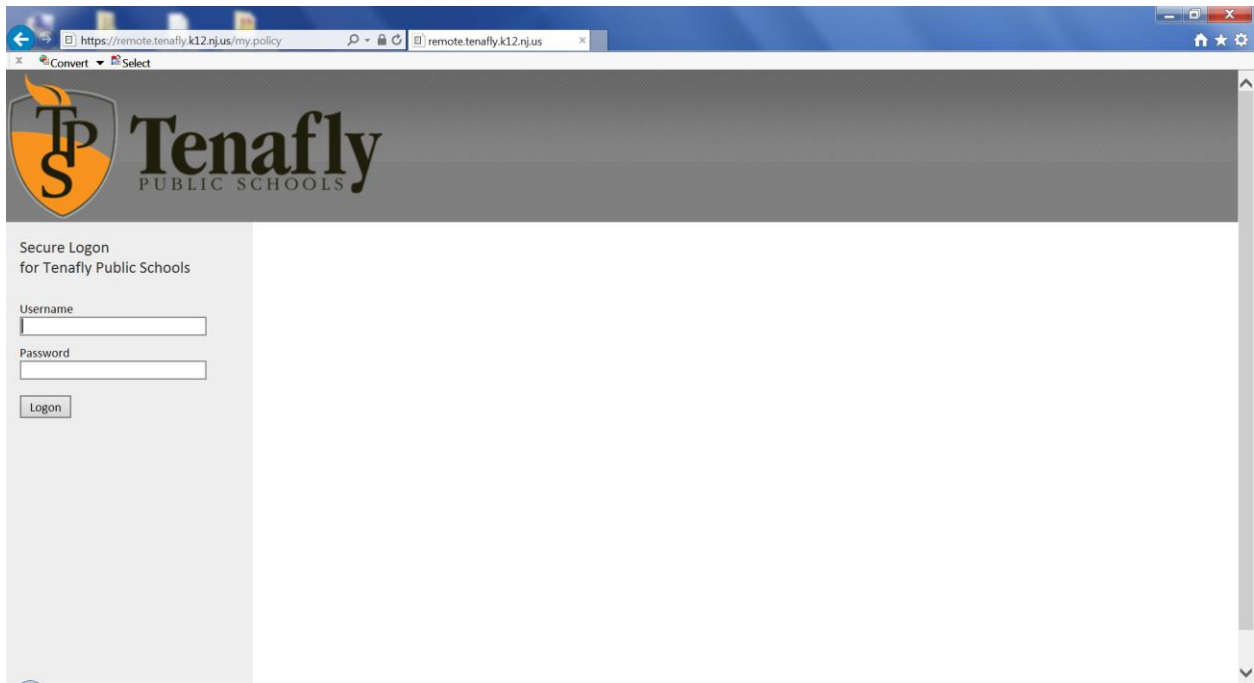
Here are a few screen shots to show the login process on a Windows system using IE11. You must install the plugin when prompted.



During the connection process you will see this screen below. Please click on “Add this site to your Trusted Sites list”.



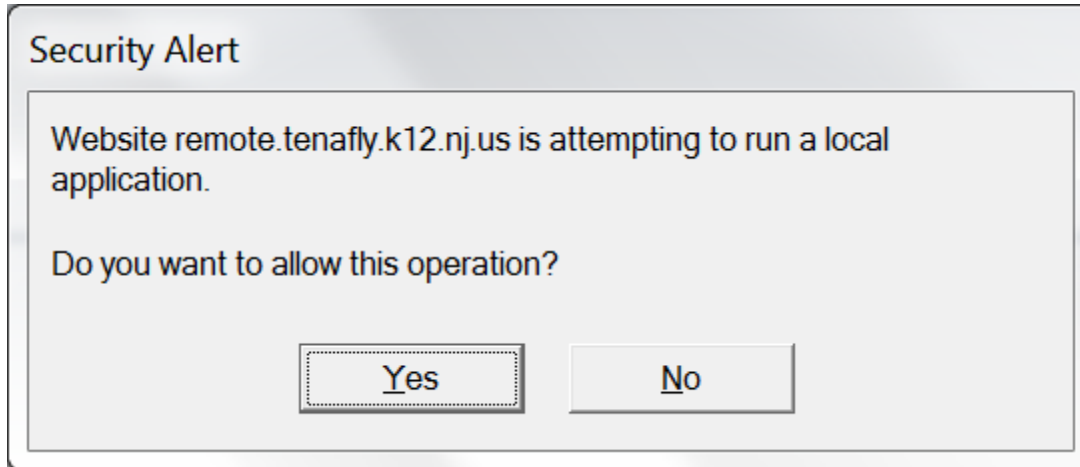
Once you are passed that screen you will be prompted to login as shown below.



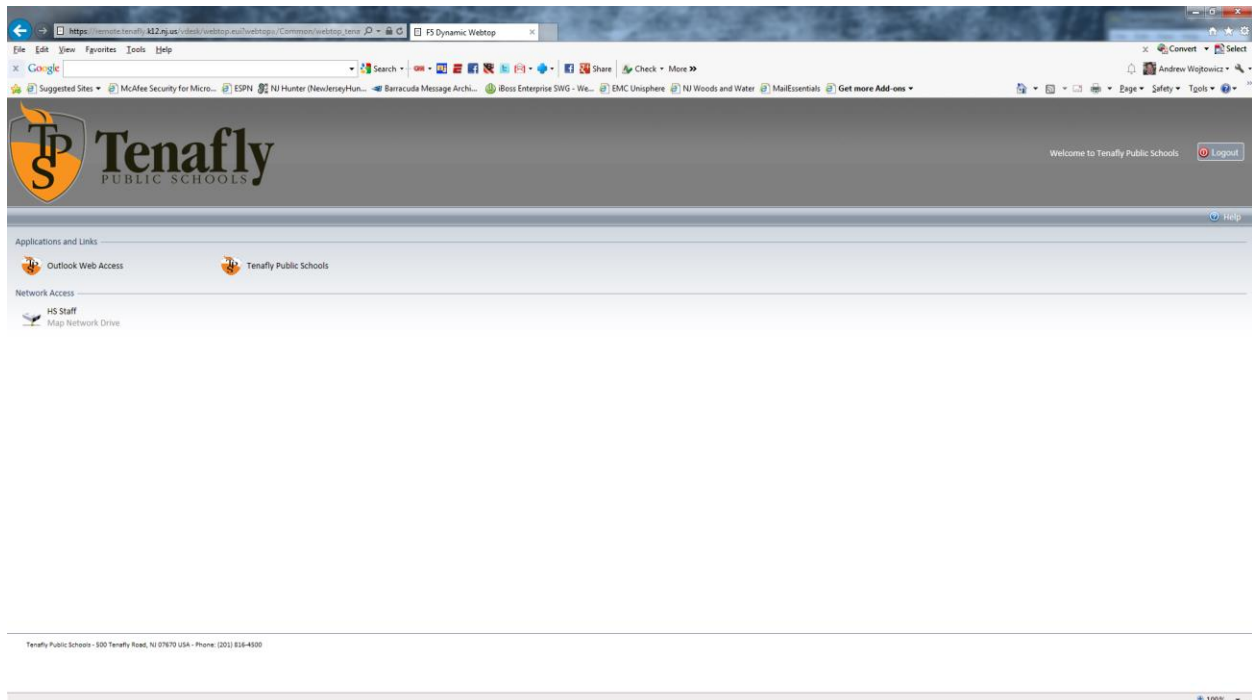
Click on the Acceptable Use Policy link to accept it and continue.




You can see this “Security Alert” screen. Just click yes to move forward.

Once fully loaded you will get your “Computer” screen to pop-up and you will see drive mappings to the G drive, Desktop and My Documents.
